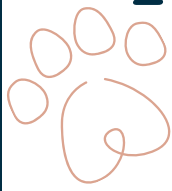


# **THE COURTHOUSE HOTEL**



## **Doggy Code of Conduct**



- The Courthouse Hotel will welcome dogs into the outdoor areas of the venue from open - 7pm, 7 days a week
- All dogs must be kept on a lead and under control of their owner at all times
- All dogs must be immunised and comply with all state and local regulations
- All dogs must be supervised at all times, and owners must not leave pets unattended at any time
- Owners are responsible for making sure their dogs remain safely out of the way and do not present a hazard to employees, other customers or their dogs
- Owners are responsible for monitoring their dog's behaviour and mood, and removing any pet that might be over-excited, aggressive or anxious
- Owners are responsible for monitoring their dog's needs and tending to any accidents that do occur immediately. If further cleaning is required, the owner must report it to the venue staff immediately
- As needed, The Courthouse Hotel may establish limits for the number of dogs allowed on the premises at a time.
- The Courthouse Hotel has the right to ask a dog owner to remove their pet from the premises at any time
- Owners are legally responsible for the behaviour of their dog
- Dogs with history of violent or aggressive behaviour are not permitted
- Damaged or broken property of The Courthouse Hotel that is caused by a dog must be paid for by the dog owner
- By bringing a dog onto The Courthouse Hotel premises, owners agree to indemnify and hold harmless the business and its owners, against any and all liabilities that may arise from the pet being on the premises
- Please note, functions take precedents. Owners are to be aware that there may be days when the venue is closed to dogs due to function bookings in the allocated dog-friendly areas
